

Academic Cooperation Agreement between Feng Chia University, Taichung, Taiwan and Sam Patulangi University, Manada

Between Feng Chia University, Taichung, Taiwan, and Sam Ratulangi University, Manado, Indonesia, an agreement has reached concerning the enhancement of academic exchange and cooperation, as well as the promotion of greater knowledge and understanding of each State's history, technology, culture, economics, and social life.

The area and scope of this Agreement are as follows:

- 1. The academic faculty members of both universities, upon invitation, will lecture and conduct seminars or research in the host institution. Such members' duration of stay, academic activities, remuneration, and other expenses will be arranged in accordance with the conditions of Feng Chia University and Sam Ratulangi University.
- 2. Both Universities agree to send students to the other University to pursue advanced studies and/or researches. The number of exchange students and financial arrangements shall be defined in a separate written agreement between the two institutions.
- 3. Both Universities agree to develop a cooperative program that focused on exchange and joint publications, joint researches, academic theses, and exchange information in certain fields of interest.
- 4. Both Universities further agree to set up International Joint Research Center to promote implementation and innovation of the research result projects.

This Agreement shall take effect on the date of signing. Each party shall hold a copy of the signed agreement. The term of this Agreement is for the first 3 (three) years and will be renewed automatically with a period of 3 (three) years, unless one party sends a written notice to cancel the Agreement. It may be terminated by either of the parties six month before the end period, with a written notice.
