JOINT DECLARATION OF COOPERATION

Sam Ratulangi University and Tokyo University of Marine Science and Technology form this agreement for the purpose of deepening our friendship and for expanding mutual understanding between the institutions through academic and educational cooperation.

The following forms of cooperation will be pursued to promote contact and understanding between the institutions:

- 1. Collaboration among faculty and staff members for research, symposia, and other academic pursuits as feasible and mutually agreed;
- 2. Exchange visits by students as mutually agreed and jointly arranged;
- 3. Joint research activities when mutually agreed and feasible; and
- 4. Exchanges of informational materials on education, training, and research matters.

Specific programs or projects developed under the above areas of cooperation will be covered by separate agreements between the institutions. The availability of funds will determine financial arrangements for specific programs or projects.

Both institutions agree that this cooperation agreement is subject to review every two years in order to evaluate ongoing program activities and their effectiveness, and to modify the agreement through mutual consent when needed.

Either institution may cancel this agreement by presenting a written notification to the other institution six months prior to the date of scheduled expiration.

This agreement becomes effective from the date it is signed by authorized representatives of the respective institutions.

JOINT DECLARATION OF COOPERATION

Student Exchange Program between Sam Ratulangi University and Tokyo University of Marine Science and Technology

I. PURPOSE

In recognition of the proven value of international experiences for students, Sam Ratulangi University and Tokyo University of Marine Science and Technology establish this Agreement to facilitate exchanges between the two institutions.

II. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this Agreement is to encourage international educational cooperation and exchange of undergraduate and graduate students between the two institutions.

III. SCOPE

This Agreement may be applied to any appropriate academic field at either institution, subject to the prior approval of the administration of the host institution.

IV. EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS

A. Applicants for participation will be selected according to the established criteria for this program. They will be selected by the home institution and will be subject to acceptance by the host institution. Students should be capable of completing coursework in the language of the host country, according to institution policies.

- B. In each academic year, each institution agrees to accept a maximum of two (2) full-time students from the partner institution, for two (2) full academic semesters (one year). Students will be visiting students and will not matriculate at the host institution.
- C. All students must provide personal health, emergency evacuation and repatriation insurance that is valid in the host nation that meets the visa requirements of the host nation.
- D. Each student shall be subject to the regulations of the host institution and the host nation. Each student will enjoy the rights and privileges of students at the host institution.
- E. Students will pay tuition and activity fees at the home institution. The host institution will charge no application, admission and tuition fees.
- F. Students will pay for insurance, room, board, books and academic materials, international transportation and personal expenses.
- G. Each institution will provide students with orientation programs, immigration advice, academic advice, support services, and housing assistance, as available to international students.

EFFFFFF KARR H. The institutions will provide each other with adequate information on the performance of exchange students, including the furnishing of official transcripts. The credits from the host institution may be transferred to the home institution, subject to approval by the home institution. V. ADMINISTRATION OF THE AGREEMENT Each institution will appoint a liaison officer who shall be responsible for all matters concerned with this Agreement. VI. DURATION, CONDITIONS AND MODIFICATIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT A. This Agreement is effective upon the signature of the designated officials of each institution. B. This Agreement will be valid for five (5) years from the date of signature. C. Modifications may be made to the Agreement, upon written acceptance by both institutions. D. Either of these institutions may terminate this Agreement with twelve (12) months' written advance notice. Exchanges planned or in progress when termination is instituted will be satisfactorily completed. E. The Agreement may be renewed by mutual consent of both parties, following an evaluation of all components of the program.
