Letter of Cooperation

BETWEEN

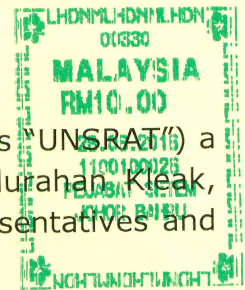
SAM RATULANGI UNIVERSITY, INDONESIA

AND

UNIVERSITI TEKNOLOGI MALAYSIA

This Letter of Cooperation ("LoC") is made between:

UNIVERSITAS SAM RATULANGI (hereinafter referred to as "UNSRAT") a state university whose address is at Kampus UNSRAT, Kelurahan Kleak, Manado 95115, Indonesia, and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns; and



UNIVERSITI TEKNOLOGI MALAYSIA (hereinafter referred to as "UTM") a public Research University established by virtue of the Malaysian universities and University Colleges Act 1971, whose address is at 81310 Sekudai, Johor, Malaysia and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns;

(UNSRAT and UTM hereinafter referred to a singularity as "the party" and collectively as "the Parties")

Article 1: Introduction

Both Universities want to collaborate with each other so as to promote the advancement of international understanding, dissemination of learning and strengthening of cultural ties on the basis of equality and mutual benefit. They have entered into this LOC to create a foundation from which such collaboration may be developed.

Article 2: Fields of Collaboration

Collaboration between both Universities will include the research collaboration and promotion of academic in the areas of built environment, architecture, landscape architecture, sustainable design and other disciplines offered at both Universities.

Article 3: Forms of Collaboration

Both Universities agree and acknowledge that collaboration may develop in the following programs, but not limited to:

- (a) Exchanges of information, knowledge and materials;
- (b) Promotion of collaborative research and publication by researchers from both Universities;
- (c) Facilitation of the mutual exchange in the use of research laboratories and literature;
- (d) Joint research and development (R&D) for international research funding, subject to approval of both Universities;



- (e) Promotion of the exchange of academic activities including academic discussions, seminars, conferences, conducting research and/or supervision student project; and
- (f) Other related fields as mutual agreed by both Universities in future.

Article 4: Cost and Expenses

Any cost and expenses incurred in performing any activity pursuant to the collaborative programs shall be negotiated to the mutual acceptance of both Universities.

Article 5: Nominated and Representatives


Each University's nominated representative is responsible for the development and implementation of this LOC, including receiving and acting on proposals for collaborative activities

Article 6: Duration and Termination

- (a) The collaborative programs shall enter into force at the day of signature by the signatory of each party and shall remain in force for three (3) years unless terminated by one of the University by giving one (1) month notice to the other.
- (b) The collaborative programs shall be reviewed at the end of second (2) year to determine the effectiveness to continue or terminate.
- (c) Where such termination occurs, the provision of the collaborative programs shall continue to apply to on-going activities until their completion.


